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## Intel Reform & Terrorism Prevention Act (Section 1016)

“The President shall—

- (A) create an information sharing environment for the sharing of terrorism information in a manner consistent with national security and with applicable legal standards relating to privacy and civil liberties;
- (B) designate the organizational and management structures that will be used to operate and manage the ISE; and
- (C) determine and enforce the policies, directives, and rules that will govern the content and usage of the ISE.”



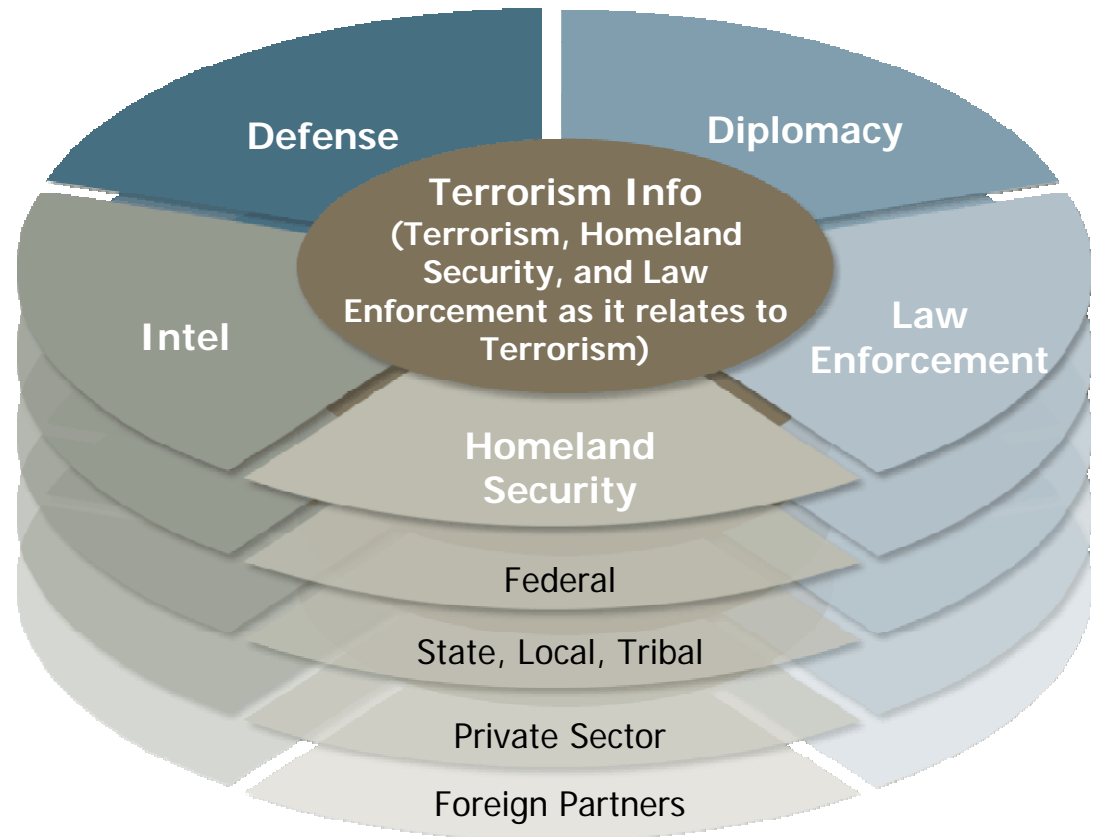
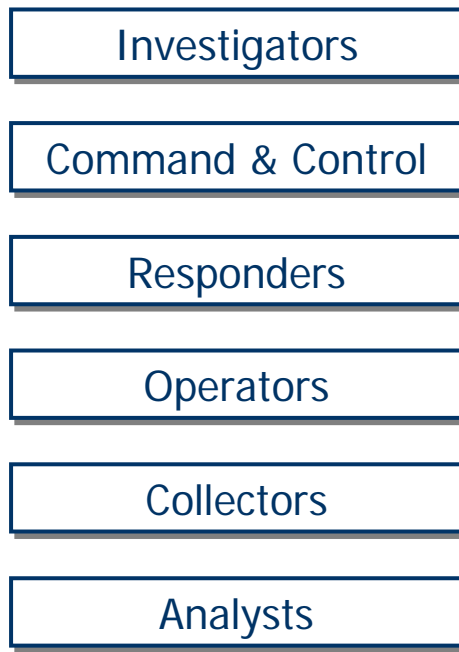

## *What is the ISE?*

- ✓ Policies, processes/protocols and technology
- ✓ Sharing of information between and among Federal, State, local, tribal and private sector entities, and foreign partners
- ✓ Direct, continuous **online access** to information
- ✓ Information is readily available for analysis, investigations and operations **without sacrificing security**
- ✓ Builds on **existing capabilities** and investments
- ✓ **Controls access to data** - not systems & networks
- ✓ Facilitates sharing at and across **all levels of security**
- ✓ Provides **directories** for locating people and information
- ✓ **Protects privacy** and other legal rights of Americans
- ✓ Better mechanisms to **enhance accountability** & oversight

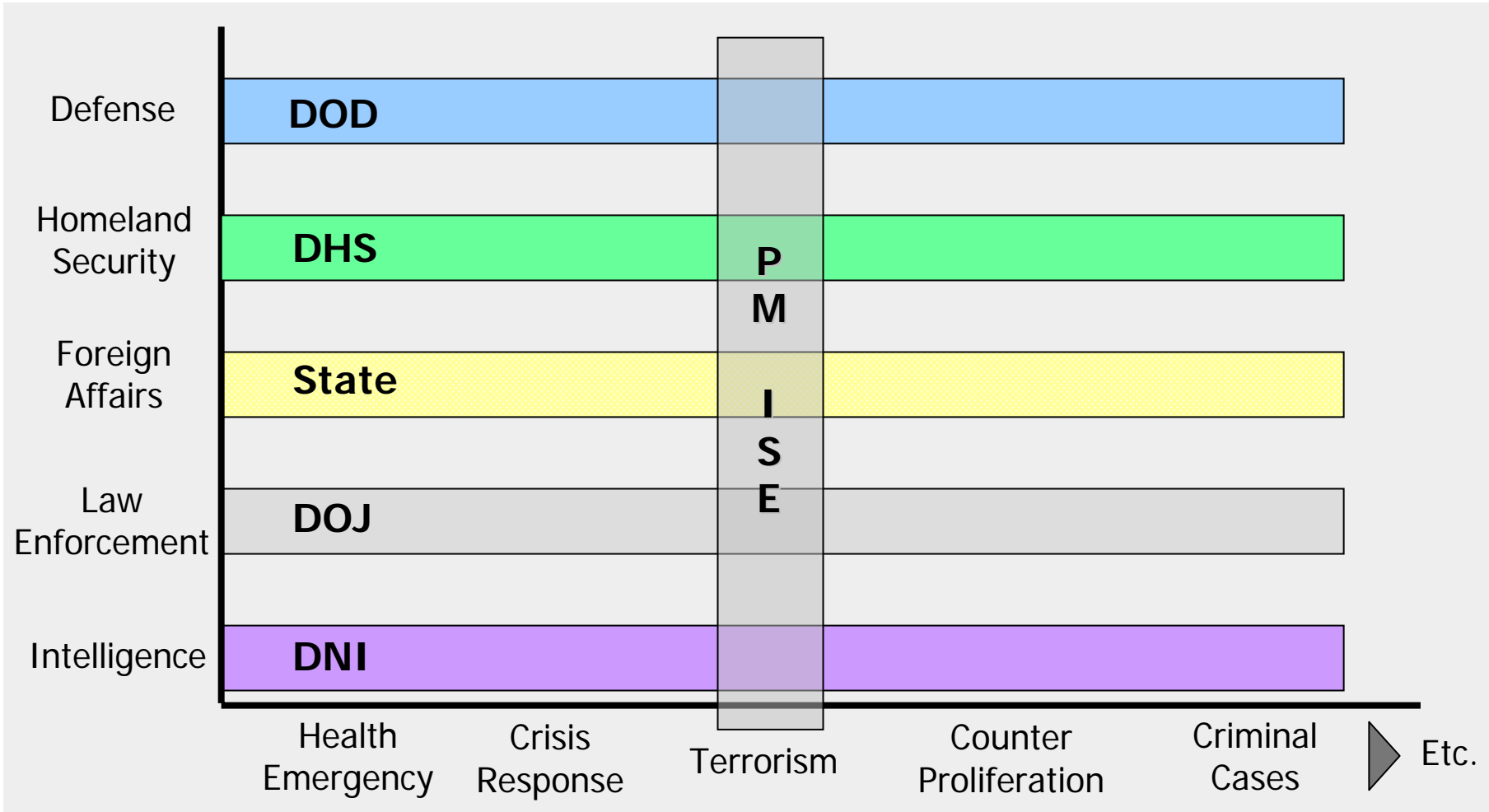

# ISE Implementation

## *Critical Implementation Areas*

- **Presidential Guidelines and Requirements\*** identified these critical areas
  1. ISE Operational Capabilities (e.g. electronic directory services)
  2. Architecture and Standards
  3. Terrorism Information Handling
  4. Sharing with Partners Outside the Federal Government
  5. Protecting Privacy and Civil Liberties in the ISE
  6. Promoting a Culture of Sharing
